## **TOPIC: REQUIREMENTS AND QUALITY ASSURANCE TESTING**

In her presentation titled "Requirements and Quality Assurance Testing," Karyn Volk, Senior Consultant with Orasi Software, introduces the importance of good Requirements and how you, as a Quality Assurance Tester, can improve the success of your project by helping to clarify the requirements that you are given.

For over twenty years, Karyn has participated in the full Software Development Lifecycle in the Banking, Financial Services, Insurance, Telecommunications, and Airline Industries. She is co-author of the one day course "Leveraging Requirements Using HP QualityCenter."

Karyn has a Bachelor of Science in Management Science, concentrating in Operations Research (Process Optimization) from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT). She is on the Board of Directors for AQAA (Atlanta Quality Assurance Association) and is an active member of the Atlanta chapter of the IIBA (International Institute of Business Analysis). **IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL CSQAs AND CSTES**

The Common Body of Knowledge (CBOK) for CSQA and CSTE was updated in 2006. Some domain areas have been changed and others have been dropped. CPE recertification points received after January 1, 2006 must align with these new domain areas. An outline that includes information on the new domain areas is available on the Software Certification



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Website, <http://www.softwarecertifications.org/>. Review this outline as you make your future training plans to ensure that your CPE credits can be applied to your recertification.

**Recertification is Now Available Online via the Customer Service Portal**

Candidates can now maintain, edit, and submit their recertification journal online through the Customer Service Portal. The new Customer Service Portal secure web pages allow you to apply online, manage your professional certifications, enroll for examinations, and view examination results all online. This has greatly reduced customer service turn-around times. The old paper-based application process has been eliminated and will no longer be accepted

**PROMETRIC™**

In 2008, Software Certifications selected Prometric, a world leader in assessment testing services, as its partner for the administration of certification examinations. Instead of having only four dates a year to take examinations at a given location, candidates can schedule a test via the Internet and take it at a **Prometric Testing Center**. Candidates must first register through the Customer Portal. After receiving a Prometric Exam Code and waiting at least 72 hours, then a candidate can schedule the exam with Prometric.
